UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA
COLLEGE OF NURSING**

TITLE: UNPLANNED CLOSING OF THE UNIVERSITY: MISSED CLASSES AND/OR CLINICAL EXPERIENCES

POLICY: Students in the College of Nursing are expected to be in compliance with all University of Florida and College of Nursing progression policies.

RATIONALE: Progression in College of Nursing courses is dependent upon the student's ability to meet established course objectives.

PROCEDURE:

In the case of an emergency or other unplanned closing of the University in which students miss class or clinical experiences:

1. Students will be evaluated on the successful attainment of course objectives and evaluation criteria, rather than on total hours of instruction based upon course credits.
2. Faculty members will provide appropriate alternatives as needed to assist students in achievement of course objectives.
