Student Software & Cloud Storage

- HSC students can now use One Drive cloud storage features, but still not approved for PHI
- All students eligible for free Microsoft Office Products
 - Up to 5 devices, including mobile

No Email Forwarding

- Student Email Forwarding Policy
- “The University of Florida's Auto-Forwarding Email policy prohibits the automatic forwarding of UF business-related electronic email.”
- Office 365 email cannot be forwarded by default; automatic compliance
- **We do check and enforce this policy!**

Mobile Computing and Storage Devices

- All mobile devices must be encrypted
 - Includes smartphones and laptops
 - Policy in effect since August 17th 2013
 - “As members of the University of Florida Constituency...”
(students are included in the requirements)
- What is encryption?
 - A process that takes a message and makes it unreadable except to a person who knows how to "decrypt" it back into a readable form.¹
- Device encryption protects you as well as the University
 - An encrypted device is unreadable without the proper password
 - In the event a device is lost or stolen all data (tax returns, bank statements, SSN's, etc.) are vulnerable if unencrypted

Laptop Policy

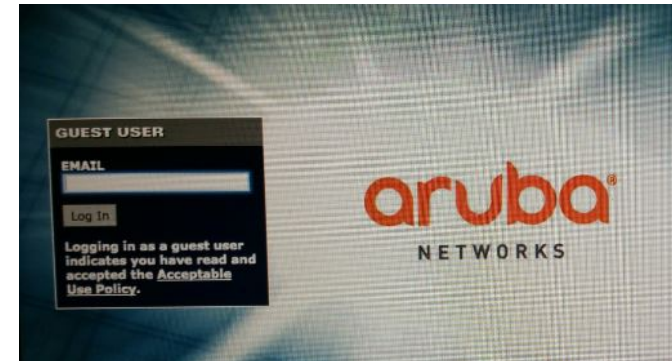
- Students are required to have a laptop and broadband internet access
